## *About the PLC*

The Pennsylvania Leadership Conference (PLC) traces its roots back to 1989 when two college students, John Fluharty and John Hanks, envisioned a conference to inspire and engage young people in the conservative movement. With the guidance of Susan Staub, Jim Panyard, Charlie Gerow, and Don Eberly, their vision became reality as the first conference launched that year – quickly establishing itself as a statewide gathering of public policy conservatives.

Following the overwhelming success of the inaugural event, leaders recognized the need for a year-round organization to unite the conservative community, giving rise to the Pennsylvania Leadership Council. Under the leadership of its president, Lowman S. Henry the Council became an umbrella organization connecting conservative groups across Pennsylvania on an issue-by-issue basis.

What began as a student-led vision has grown into the nation's largest state-based conservative conference, drawing 800-1,000 attendees annually. Over two and a half days, participants engage in workshops, receptions, keynote addresses, and networking with leading conservative thinkers, elected officials, and grassroots activists.

Over the years, the PLC has welcomed some of the nation's most prominent conservative voices to its stage. Past keynote speakers have included **Newt Gingrich, William Bennett, Lynne Cheney, Rick Santorum, Ann Coulter, Michelle Malkin, Michael Reagan, Charles Krauthammer, Jesse Watters, Ben Shapiro, Kimberly Strassel, Trey Gowdy, Kellyanne Conway, Dinesh D'Souza, and Kayleigh McEnany**, among many others. Their presence underscores the PLC's role as the premier forum for conservative ideas and leadership in Pennsylvania and across the nation.

As a non-partisan, not-for-profit organization, the PLC continues its mission at the heart of the conservative coalition working with allies to advance better schools, lower taxes, responsible spending, open government, and stronger families across the Commonwealth and beyond.

## *Important Information*

### **Security Information**

As part of the Conference Safety and Security Plan, the front driveway of the conference center will be closed at 9pm Thursday until 11am Saturday. Cars left in parking spots directly in front of the conference center may be towed at the owner's expense. Every attendee must be credentialed for access to the conference center; there is no sharing of badges and IDs will be required upon check-in to validate the badge holder.

### **Sponsor Booth Setup**

Sponsors may use the front driveway of the conference center to unload booth supplies from 7pm to 9pm Thursday. Every item entering the conference center is subject to search.

### **Sponsor Booth Hours**

Sponsor tables are accessible and should be staffed on Friday from 8am until the start of the Liberty Dinner, the doors will be locked to the room during and after dinner. Sponsor tables will reopen on Saturday at 7am until 11am.
